

Study Notes: Matthew 28:16-19 Make Disciples

Matthew 28:16-19 NIV Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. (17) When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. (18) Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. (19) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

3. Respond to this definition of discipleship. 'A disciple is an intentional lifelong learner.'
4. How do you identify a disciple? Matt 10:1; Matt 16:24; Luke 9:1; Luke 10:19; Luke 14:26; John 8:31; John 13:35; John 15:8
5. See Acts 20:28. What is the relationship between discipleship and pastoral care?
6. Sue asked the question 'How are you discipling yourself?' In what ways might you do this?
7. Sue suggested that regardless of our career, our main job is discipling. How do you respond?
8. For prayerful consideration – who could you take under your wing to help them grow as a Christian?
