 - 3. Keep in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:25) What might this mean? How would we do it?
 - Keep on being filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18) What do we learn from this verse? How might we do this?
5. John F referred to Jesus' invitation at the Feast of Tabernacles John 7:37-39. How may we drink of the living water?
6. Are there some questions concerning the Holy Spirit that you would like to explore/discuss? What are they?
