



Opportunities to serve in the church – January 2016

Alpha ministry – publicity, prayer, invitations, preparing meals, leading groups, one-to-ones
Babysitting – to allow others to go to evening church events
Befriending – building new relationships in the local community, inviting people to church
Blessings team (new) – celebrating birthdays, cards and flowers for people unwell or recovering
Book and card stall – organised by Mandy Fortune – help with promotion / book reviews etc.
CAP Money and Debt – lots of new opportunities to serve and support – more information soon
Care team – visiting, practical help (cleaning shopping etc.), preparing meals, garden and DIY
Chair rota – setting out and clearing away
Children’s work – Rainbows, Little Rainbows and crèche
Cleaning and disposal of waste (recycling) – emptying dishwashers, tidying cupboards etc.
Events – leading and support for Together at Christmas, Rugby, Football, Harvest, Easter activities
First Aid – providing cover for services and meetings (training provided)

Freedom in Christ and Grace Ministry – Leading, supporting, ‘steps’ and prayer support
Gardening – front garden and forecourt, back garden at Number Seven
Ladies / men’s ministry – Inspired, Men’s supper, Integrity
Maintenance – minor repairs and decorating
Magazine – writing articles, proof reading, graphic design and presentation
Missionary support– prayer, and maintaining awareness through newsletters church presentations
Pastoral ministry / discipleship
Prayer and encouragement team
Prayer ministry and intercession – prayer bus
Refreshment team – serving tea and coffee – clearing and loading dishwasher
Resources – organising and helping to manage the church library
Small group leadership – home groups – hosting – inviting people round for coffee
Social – inviting people to meals or organising social events
Sound / AV team
Spectrum and young people’s work – opportunities for midweek groups
Sports – table tennis club – sports night for young (and older) people, organising walks
Teaching team – Sunday talks, short courses (marriage, parenting etc), Reflect and discussion groups
Toddlers – Wednesday and Friday mornings, registration, drinks, playing, chatting with carers, prayer
Visiting team – hospital and home visits in the community (DBS check needed)
Welcome team – welcoming people on Sunday mornings
Worship team – singing or playing musical instruments to bless others at various church activities
