25 th Pray for the continuing success of our life -skills programme as we re- start this year. It's a great time for the girls to ask questions and discuss their feelings. Pray for open hearts to receive.	26 th Pray for Aunty Eli and her health challenges. Pray she will remain strong to carry out all the tasks required of her as she leads the girls centre. Pray for her brother who is battling gangrene in his foot due to diabetes.	27 th Pray for one of our boys in Gyero called Elisha who is battling seizures. The seizures seem to be getting worse and the medication is expensive.
